REGISTRATION 2018

Registration will be available online only starting February 1, 2018. Visit the Olmsted Community Center website at http://olmstedcc.com to register. You may contact the Olmsted Community Center with any questions at (440) 427-1599.

Register on or before February 28, 2018, to earn a \$5 discount per player. The last day to register without a late fee is March 31, 2018. Late fee registrations will only be accepted until April 15, 2018, if there is available space in the desired league(s). Payment for registrations not accepted after the April 15th deadline will be refunded.

THE FAMILY MAXIMUM THROUGH MARCH 31, 2018, is \$235.00. Late fees are <u>not</u> included in the family maximum. Proof of age may be required at a later date for all leagues. Registrations may be limited due to field availability.
