- Games: Thurs. or Fri.
- Players will be placed on teams by League Administrator not based on assessments.

VOLUNTEER COACHES ARE NEEDED. WE WILL NOT START THIS PROGRAM UNTIL WE HAVE A COACH FOR EACH TEAM.

COST: \$45 per player (includes team t-shirt).

2. Recreational <u>Travel</u> Basketball League (1st – 4th Gr.) All games on weekends in Berea

- Volunteer Coaches PAID Scorekeepers & Referees.
- Teams will play Berea & other O.F. Teams ~ Will travel to Berea for Games.
- All practices held at Falls/Lenox School.
- Practices: Mon Fri
- Games: Played in Berea 1st-2nd on Saturday, 3rd-4th on Saturday or Sunday
- Players will be placed on balanced teams by OCC based on Mandatory Skills Assessment November 1st, 2nd & 3rd
- approx. 8-10 weeks. ~ This program may feature a single-elimination end-of-the-season tournament.

COST: \$75 per player (includes reversible jersey & fees for gym rental time, referees & scorekeepers).

OCC WINTER BASKETBALL PROGRAMS

Recreational Travel Basketball League

GRADES 5th – 8th / **GRADES** 9th – 12th

(1st-4th Grade info on back)

There are no cuts. All players who register will play. There will be equal playing time for all participants. After player assessments, players will be divided to make teams equal rather than A & B levels. Limited space – Max of 10 players per team!

DIVISIONS: Boys 5th & 6th Grades // Boys 7th & 8th Grades

PRACTICES: Beginning in November, 2019 ~ End of February, 2020. Practices will be during the week at the Olmsted Community Center. *If additional practice times can be scheduled before the game season begins there may be two practices a week and some may be on the weekends.*

<u>GAMES</u>: This league involves teams from Berea, Brook Park, Middleburg Heights, Fairview, North Olmsted, Westlake, Columbia Station, Strongsville, Brecksville, Brooklyn, & Rocky River. Games begin December 7th, weekends one hour between 9:00am-9:00pm – End of Feb. 2020. Games on Saturdays or Sundays (and possibly a few weeknights) and held in any of the communities that have teams represented. Be prepared to travel. Season *will* include an end of season single-elimination tournament.

COST: \$150.00 Fee includes cost of gym rental time, referees & scorekeepers plus reversible game jersey.

DIVISIONS: Boys 9th & 10th Grades (Junior Varsity) // Boys 11th & 12th Grades (Varsity)

PRACTICES: Beginning in late Nov. thru early March, 2020 at the Olmsted Community Center.

<u>GAMES</u>: All one-hour games will be played at Brook Park Rec Center on THURSDAY evenings beginning January 9, 2020. Season includes an end-of-season tournament in March 2020.
