REGISTRATION 2017

Registration will be available online starting February 1, 2017. Visit the Olmsted Community Center website at <http://olmstedcc.com> to register. You may also obtain a registration form by visiting the Olmsted Community Center, the Olmsted Falls Library, at the Olmsted Falls Schools, and/or by printing one from the Olmsted Community Center or OCSL website. **We require that you complete one registration form per player.**

Register on or before February 28th, 2017, to earn a \$5 discount per player. The last day to register without a late fee is March 31, 2017. All mailed registration forms must be postmarked by March 31, 2017, or will be subject to a \$20 late fee per player. **Late fee registrations will only be accepted until April 15, 2017, if there is available space in the desired league(s).** Payment for registrations not accepted after the April 15th deadline will be returned.

THE FAMILY MAXIMUM THROUGH MARCH 31, 2017, is \$235.00. Late fees are **not** included in the family maximum. Proof of age may be required at a later date for all leagues. Registrations may be limited due to field availability.
